

# Career Pathways

Goal: State funding to sustain immersive student pathways and Office of Work-Based Learning

#### **Previous Wins:**

FY20 budget funds employer engagement in work-based learning





Goal: Increase Purchase of Care subsidy to reimburse for the true cost of child care

Goal: Expand access and increase quality of state-funded pre-k, investing toward universal, voluntary, full-day, high-quality prekindergarten, starting with 4-year-olds

Goal: Establish common, online registration and enrollment process for families

Goal: Further consolidate early childhood governance by moving IDEA Part C to DOE

#### **Previous Wins:**

FY21 budget sustains STARS and POC, requires new cost of care study, and consolidates some ECE governance



# Fair & Efficient Funding

Goal: In partnership with Education Equity Delaware coalition, build upon lawsuit settlement floor by increasing funding for student need, and to begin transition to weighted student funding formula
